Here are some comments to your question from Jim Humble for you:

In the past some people have been able to use MMS and quit taking their anti-rejection drugs. In fact most people who tried it were able to overcome using the drugs. We cannot guarantee that this will work for you.

The way to find out is to start taking 1/8th drop of MMS1 each hour for a full day, then if no problem go to 1/4 drop each hour for a full day, then to 1/2 drop, then 3/4 drop, then 1 drop, then 2 drops, then 3 drops, and then continue for three weeks at 3 drops.

In my opinion you should not need the anti-rejection drugs by that time. But go slow. If negative indications show up, of course, stop.

How to do it. Make a 1 drop dose, and then discard 7/8ths of it and add some water to the 1/8th left and drink it. Do this hourly. Continue that way.

MMS kills the poisons that prevents kidneys from working.
